King David Memorial Garden (Gan Zikaron Hamelech David)

The King David Memorial Garden is the Jewish section of our Gardens and is located in the western section. It is a completely natural bordered area for Jewish "green" burials, with a natural prairie lawn (not manicured) and the spectacular classic view of Longs Peak and Mt. Meeker in the Rocky Mountains.

Plots in this section are open to any Jewish person and that person's spouse, partner, child, or family member. At least one member of a couple or family must be Jewish, of any branch of Judaism. We do not require synagogue membership or affiliation, and we allow traditional full burial and cremation burial.

This section uses traditional Jewish plain pine caskets, shrouds, wicker baskets, or biodegradable cremation urns, but no container is required. All plots are prepared with a combination of machinery and hand-digging. Plots can be partially closed with the traditional Jewish *mitzvah* of mourners placing soil by hand and then completed by our professional grounds keeper and cemetery staff.

Two people can share one plot if at least one person is cremated. We allow up to six cremains per plot.

Markers in this section are slanted stones native to Colorado with bronze plaques and can be ordered from us. Markers are typically installed between a few months and one year after burial, in time for an unveiling ceremony. The plaque contains the person's English and Hebrew names, the birth and death dates in the regular calendar and the Hebrew calendar, plus the five traditional Hebrew letters ה.ב.ג.ד.ה. Generally, there is also a Star of David and a short phrase about the person's life.

In keeping with Jewish tradition, this section does not allow grave liners, vaults, embalming, wreaths, flowers, or vases. It does not allow any religious symbols other than the Star of David.

Because this area is a natural prairie lawn with no irrigation, we do not allow any trees or bushes to be planted on the plot.

The Rabbinic Consecration Ceremony for this section was held on October 24, 2021.
